



## **St. Ita's School Uniform Policy**

### **Introduction:**

It is our policy that all pupils from Junior Infants to Sixth Class must wear the school uniform when attending school or when participating in a school organised event.

### **1. Our uniform consists of the following options:**

#### **Option1**

- Grey uniform trousers.
- White polo shirt.
- Wine-coloured V-necked knitted jumper with crest.
- Footwear should consist of practical, flat and comfortable walking shoes or runners.

#### **Option2**

- Wine coloured pinafore with a white polo shirt or white blouse and crested wine cardigan.

### **2. P.E. Days:**

The school uniform on P.E. days is the school tracksuit (wine-coloured track pants and wine-coloured and crested sweatshirt) with white polo shirt. Runners must be worn with the tracksuit.

### **Important Note:**

- The school crest forms part of the school uniform.
- Parents have the option of buying the St Ita's crest and stitching it onto the clothing.
- The School Uniform Policy will be reviewed by the Board of Management on a regular basis and your opinions will be welcome.
