



ST. ITA'S NATIONAL SCHOOL LOUGHREA SCHOOL UNIFORM POLICY

1. Uniform is obligatory from 1st to 6th (inclusive).

The uniform consists of:-

{wine coloured pinafore
wine coloured cardigan with crest
white blouse
wine tie
wine tights
white/wine socks}

{School tracksuit

white coloured polo shirt (No coloured t-shirts acceptable)}

For boys it is a wine coloured pullover with crest, grey shirt, wine tie and grey slacks.

Boys may

also wear the wine coloured tracksuit.

2. School tracksuit MUST be worn on P.E. Days, however, if the tracksuit is unavailable for any

reason on the day, the pinafore MUST be worn with shorts underneath and runners.

3. As agreed with the Parents Association and the school, pupils may wish and are allowed to wear

school tracksuit during the colder months (i.e. the period between Halloween Break – St. Patrick's Day.) However if school tracksuit is unavailable on any day during this

period for

any reason, school pinafore etc. MUST be worn.

4. On special occasions during the school year full uniform (pinafore/shirt/tie/cardigan/socks)

MUST be worn.

5. From September to Halloween and from St. Patrick's Day to the end of June, the

school

pinafore must be worn. School tracksuit may be worn on P.E. days.

6. In the event of a child coming to school and not wearing the school uniform/tracksuit, the child's

teacher will inform the principal. The principal will contact the child's parents/guardians and the

parents/guardians must make arrangements for the child to change into the school uniform/tracksuit.
